Casa Del Marques Rioja	£5.50
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A modern Rioja with black cherry fruit character and a hint of spice from the few months in oak.

Casa Del Marques Rioja 2015 £18.00

A modern Rioja with black cherry fruit character and a hint of spice from the few months in oak.

Etna Rosso Tenute della Terre Nere 2014 £30.50

From grapes grown organically in the soils of Mount Etna. Medium bodied and rich in mineral character.

Pinot Noir Vina Leyda Las Brisas 2015 £33.50

From one of Chile's newest wine regions. Strawberry fruit character and underlying toastiness.

The Conductor Merlot (Philip Shaw) 2015 £24.00

Rich, Fruity and well balanced Australian Red. Blackcurrant & damson flavours with a touch of spice.

Louis Latour 2013 £36.00

Elegant and smooth with delicate summer fruit aromas and flavours.

Savigny les Beaune Benjamin Leroux 2014 £50.00

An elegant red Burgundy from a small producer. Silky smooth with subtle aromas and flavours of strawberry and cherry.

Chateau La Croix des Moines 2013

Lalande de Pomerol £40.00

A well-structured Bordeaux. Rich in flavour and body with firm tannins making it ideal with steak and game.

Chateau Lacoste Borie 2012 £60.00

The second wine from Grand Puy Lacoste. Drinking superbly at the moment. Classic Pauillac, with rich, earthy, mineral richness.

Beaune 1er Cru Vignes Franches

Louis Latour 2010 £75.00

A robust, rich, ripe Burgundy from a great vineyard. Structured and complex.

Duas Pedras Alentejano 2013 £26.50

From southern Portugal, a modern, harmonious wine. Hints of violet on the nose and lots of ripe black fruits flavours on the palate.

Malbec Don David Michel Torino 2016 £26.00

From high in the foothills of the Argentine Andes, a rich red with black fruit flavours and hints of coffee and chocolate.

Vacqueyras Vidal Fleury 2014 £38.50

A well structured southern Rhone red similar in style to a Chateauneuf du Pape. Ripe and mellow black and red fruit flavours with plenty of body and a hint of pepper and spice on the finish.

Vina Real Crianza 2012 £26.50

Medium bodied Rioja combining ripe dried fruit flavours with vanilla oak.

Marques de Murrieta Rioja Reserva 2012 £36.50

Traditional Rioja from a long established Bodega. Complex and mellow with ripe, spicy dried fruit flavours that stay on the palate.

St. Estephe

Chateau Meyney 1994 £65.00

Cru Bourgeois - An expertly managed chateau, selecting only the best vats to produce big wines. (Bin 112)

Chateau Cos Labory 1994 £95.00

5eme Grand Cru Classe - Well-structured with a classic old claret nose. (Bin 113)

Chateau Tour De Pez 1996 £80.00

Cru Bourgeois - Big and textural palate with hints of sweet oak (Bin 114)

Chateau Montrose 1970 £295.00

2eme Grand Cru Classe - A benchmark vintage for Ch. Montrose. 45 years on and the '70 is characteristically grippy and full. (Bin 115)

Chateau Montrose 1982 £475.00

2eme Grand Cru Classe - At its prime now, rustic St. Estephe at its earthy best. (Bin 116)

Pauillac

Chateau Grand Puy-Lacoste 1993 £90.00

Grand Cru Classe - Not quite as big as other Pauillacs but still showing classic characteristics as sweet cassis and oaky notes. (Bin 117)

Chateau Duhart-Milon 1994 £140.00

Cru Bourgeois
Owned by the Rothschilds, the 1994 was a great year showing defined structure. (Bin 118)

Chateau Pichon Longueville 1994 £160.00

2eme Grand Cru Classe - Incredibly well structured combining cedar notes with intense fruit. (Bin 119)

Chateau Carruades de Lafite 1996 £430.00

The second wine of Lafite-Rothschild, not overly dense, composed classic claret nose and the fruit is still prevalent.. (Bin 120)

Chateau Lynch-Bages 1970 £295.00

5eme Grand Cru Classe - Focused cedar and cigar box aromas, a surprising amount of fruit on the finish. (Bin 121)

Chateau Mouton Rothchild 1994 £330.00

1er Grand Cru Classe - Drinking beautifully now and will easily go another 10-15 years. (Bin 123)

Chateau du Cruzeau 1995 (Magnum) £125.00

Bought by Andre Lurton in the mid 70's, now producing wines with real finesse. (Bin 124)

Chateau Mazaris 1996 Canon Fronsac **£110.00**
Grand Cru Bourgeois - Soft on the palate with a headline of plum and a touch of mineral tang (Bin 101)

Left Bank

Haut Medoc

Chateau Bernadotte 1996 **£60.00**
Cru Bourgeois. Under new ownership since the mid 90's, quality has been improving year on year. (Bin 102)

Chateau Lamothe Bergeron 1996 **£70.00**
Cru Bourgeois - An expertly managed chateau, selecting only the best vats to produce big wines (Bin 103)

Chateau Cambon la Pelouse 2002 **£75.00**
Cru Bourgeois. Surprisingly youthful and still showing good fruit with a medium body. (Bin 104)

Chateau Sociando-Mallet 1993 **£95.00**
Cru Bourgeois Exceptionnel. A Chateau that unlike many uses up to 100% new oak, producing deeply rich and structured wines. The 1993 is no exception. (Bin 105)

Chateau Potensac 1994 **£95.00**
Cru Bourgeois. A classic Haut-Medoc with touches of cedar wood and real earthiness. (Bin 106)

St. Julien

Chateau Beychevelle 1993 **£200.00**
4e Cru Class. A classic Saint-Julien with touches of dark fruit and real earthiness. (Bin 108)

Grand Vin de Leoville du Marquis de Las Cases 1970 **£298.00**
Powerful and heady despite its age, as good as most classed growths of the same age. (Bin 109)

Chateau Leoville-Barton 1982 **£310.00**
2eme Grand Cru Classe - One of the greatest Bordeaux vintages of the last century, this '82 needs time to decant but will reward with enticing complexity and incredible length. (Bin 110)

Chateau Chasse-Spleen 1994, **£70.00**
Grand Cru Bourgeois Exceptionnel
A touch lighter than the 1993 with a little less intensity (Bin 111)

Red Wines

Corimbo Ribera del Duero 2012 **£45.00**
A classy dense Ribera. Rich and powerful with black fruit, tobacco leaf and cedary character.

Chateau Musar 2009 **£56.50**
From Lebanon's best known winery. Smooth and balanced, with soft tannins and complex mature fruit flavours.

Shiraz Kilikanoon Killerman's Run 2014 **£30.00**
Very smooth Australian Shiraz. Full flavoured and well-balanced with lots of juicy, tangy fruit together with ripe, well integrated tannins.

Jordan Cabernet Sauvignon 2013 **£29.50**
Rich South African red with typical smoky black fruit and cigar box aromas. Full on the palate with ripe blackcurrant fruit character.

Brunello di Montalcino Il Poggione 2012 **£66.50**
Rich, complex Italian red with ripe, spicy fruit and hints of liquorice.

Amarone Classico della Valpolicella Crosara 2010 **£78.00**
A concentrated and very intense style of wine with violet and black cherry aromas followed by raisin and spice character. Very long lasting on the palate.

Verdicchio Monte Schiavo 2016 £18.00

Light Italian white. Crisp, dry and very drinkable.

Gavi di Gavi Minaia 2016 £35.50

Silky, cool and mineral with great finesse and elegance.

Petit Chablis Domaine d'Elise 2015 £30.50

Classically crisp and dry with a fine flinty character.

Rudesheimer Rosengarten Riesling 2015 £24.50

Medium Sweet & deliciously fruity German wine.

Pinot Grigio Festival Merano 2015 £26.00

A richer style of Pinot Grigio. Well balanced and full on the palate with a refreshing fruit acidity.

Albarino Carqueixal 2015 £26.50

Louis Latour 2015 £60.00

Montmains is widely regarded as one of the best Premier Crus in Chablis. This is fine, elegant and steely dry with aromas and flavours of citrus, almond and apricot.

Meursault Le Limozin 2014 £72.00

Mineral rich and steely with great structure.

Puligny Montrachet Etienne Sauzet 2014 £78.00

Elegant, well made Puligny with stone fruit character and a long mineral finish.

Lopez de Haro Rosado 2016 £18.50

A fresh, dry Rioja Rose. Easy drinking with light red fruit flavours.

Rimauresq Rose 2016 £29.00

Excellent Rose from Provence, and regarded as one of the best from the region. It has aromas and flavours of summer fruits with a hint of spice and white pepper.

Sparkling Wines

Prosecco Fiol £28.00

A fresh and dry yet fruity Prosecco.

Anna de Codorniu Blanc de Noirs £26.00

Made from Pinot Noir grapes. Crisp, dry Cava with a hint of pink.

Langlois Rose Cremant de Loire £31.00

Owned by Bollinger in the Loire Valley. A dry, full flavoured Rose.

Champagnes

Champagne Sarcey Brut £46.50

A fine and elegant Champagne from a small family producer.

Billecart Salmon Brut £71.50

One of the Island's favourite Champagnes. Dry and sophisticated.

Ruinart Blanc de Blancs £87.00

Ruinart is the oldest Champagne house. 100% Chardonnay, it is well balanced with wonderful aromas of citrus and exotic fruit.

Louis Roederer Cristal 2004 £225.00

A powerful yet delicate Champagne, combining subtlety and precision, produced only in the best vintages.

Champagne Sarcey Rose £50.00

A stylish and classy dry pink Champagne from a family run estate.

Billecart Salmon Brut Rose £92.50

Regarded as being the best non-vintage Champagne by much of the wine trade. Dry and well balanced with fine bubbles.

Dessert Wines

Monbazillac

Domaine de Grange Neuve 2011 £20.50

A versatile dessert wine. Delicious with most desserts and with cheese.

Akashi Plum Sake £30.00

A deep coloured, spicy fruity wine, well suited to richer desserts especially those based around dried fruits and chocolate.

Clos Dady Sauternes 2014 £38.00

A highly complex wine with aromas of lime, acacia and honey. The palate is luscious and generous with its sweet apricot, honey, roasted nut and marmalade flavours. Perfect with rich and fruity desserts.

Klein Constantia Vin de Constance 2013 £80.00

One of the world's finest dessert wines from South Africa. Intensely aromatic with complex flavours of orange and spice.
